

## WORKS NOTIFICATION

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. The new hospital is on track to open to patients late-2023.

### Tweed Coast Road and Cudgen Road intersection upgrade works

This intersection is being upgraded to facilitate more efficient access to the hospital when it opens to patients. The upgrade works include the provision of additional turn lanes and turning capacity; road and surfacing improvements; lighting and traffic signals; and drainage and services installation.

These important intersection upgrade works are well underway and are expected to be completed early-mid 2023.

### Works in October 2022

- Road widening works north and south of Cudgen Road.
- Drainage, pipe installation, kerb and channel, and gully pit installation.
- New street lighting being installed.

### NIGHTWORKS - commencing Sunday 30 October 2022

- **Night works** will commence on Sunday 30 October 2022 and continue for up to 3 weeks to seal road widenings and place asphalt.
- The **pedestrian crossing** from the north-west to the north-east corner of the intersection will be closed during this time, with pedestrians redirected with signage and temporary ramps.
- These works are being undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic.
- Traffic controllers will be in place to guide traffic and pedestrians.

### What to expect

- Traffic control measures including lane closures and diversions; with traffic controllers and police onsite during working hours to ensure the safety of workers and vehicles.
- A reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place on Tweed Coast Road and Cudgen Road in the vicinity of the road upgrade works.
- Short traffic delays may be experienced during this time. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience while these important road upgrades are being undertaken.
