

## **WORKS NOTIFICATION**

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. The new hospital is on track to open to patients late-2023.

### **Tweed Coast Road and Cudgen Road intersection upgrade works**

This intersection is being upgraded to facilitate more efficient access to the hospital when it opens to patients. The upgrade works will include: the provision of additional turn lanes and turning capacity; road and surfacing improvements; lighting and traffic signals; and drainage and services installation.

These important intersection upgrade works will get underway shortly and are expected to be complete early-mid 2023.

### **Works commencing from 18 July 2022**

- Vegetation clearing works will get underway on the northern side of the intersection. These works will be managed by a trained arborist and spotter and catcher.
- Preliminary earthworks will commence to the north and south of Cudgen Road.
- Drainage improvement works on Tweed Coast Road.

### **Works commencing from 24 July 2022 – Nightworks**

- Commencing Sunday 24 July 2022, works to relocate telecom services will begin and continue for several weeks.
- These works will be undertaken at night to minimise the impact on traffic.
- Most of the works will be low impact, however lane and footpath closures will be in place. Traffic controllers will be in place to guide traffic and pedestrians.

### **What to expect**

- Traffic control measures, including lane closures and traffic controllers onsite during working hours, will be in place to ensure the safety of workers and vehicles while these important road upgrades are being undertaken.
- A reduced speed limit of 40km/h on Tweed Coast and Cudgen roads in the vicinity of the road upgrade works will be in place for worker safety.
- Short traffic delays may be experienced during this time. We apologise for any inconvenience and thank you for your patience.
