

TWEED VALLEY HOSPITAL PROJECT JUNE 2023



WORKS NOTIFICATION

The NSW Government is investing \$723.3 million in Health for the Tweed-Byron region, which includes construction of the new Tweed Valley Hospital. Health Infrastructure NSW has engaged Lendlease to construct the main Hospital buildings. Construction of the new Hospital is on schedule to open to patients in 2023.

UPDATED DATES: Cudgen Road widening – Nightworks during June 2023

The widening of a section of Cudgen Road in front of the hospital site is on track for completion in mid-2023, with installation of asphalt and linemarking to be undertaken in June 2023. To minimise traffic impacts and maintain safety, these works will need to be completed outside of normal construction hours, between 6pm and 6am.

Please see below summary of nightworks:

Stage one - Asphalt works Sunday 18 to Tuesday 27 June 2023	Asphalting will be undertaken to the newly constructed sections of Cudgen Road from Sunday 18 to Tuesday 27 June, between 6pm and 6am , weather permitting. During this time a Stop/Go traffic arrangement will be in place to ensure access for through traffic is maintained along Cudgen Road, however motorists may experience short delays.
Stage two – Linemarking Two nights during late June or early July 2023	When asphaltting works is complete, line-marking of the new roads will take place over two nights during late June or early July, between 6pm and 6am . Stop/Go traffic arrangements will be in place during these works with access maintain on Cudgen Road, however motorists may experience short delays.

What to expect:

- Nightworks will be undertaken on Cudgen Road between the hours of 6pm to 6am from Sunday 18 to Tuesday 27 June, and on two additional nights to undertake linemarking in late June or early July (weather pending).
- Plant and equipment to be used during the night works include road profiler, asphalt paver, compression rollers, generator, lighting, and line-marking trucks.
- There will be noise during these works from the equipment used and vehicle movements. Lendlease will work to minimise disruptions and noise impacts to residents during these works, however some noise is unavoidable.
- Traffic control will be in place to coordinate a Stop/Go arrangement with reduced speed limits during the works.
- Vehicle access for local traffic will be maintained on Cudgen Road with minor delays expected and temporary changes to the traffic conditions, including detours, controlled lanes or reduced speed.
- If wet weather delays these activities, they will take place on the next available dates.
