Kingscliff Ambulance Station Water & Sewer Connection Works

With construction of the new Kingscliff Ambulance Station progressing, a significant milestone for this project will be the connection of the water and sewer services.


These works will occur along Cudgen Road and Turnock Street in the vicinity of the new Ambulance station site, commencing on 15 January and finishing late February. The works have been scheduled during the holiday period to minimise impact to the community.

What to expect:

The following activities will be undertaken:

- Initial investigations to confirm existing service locations.
- Water and sewer main connection works, including works alongside Cudgen Road and Turnock Street, and three road crossings of the water and sewer services infrastructure.
- Equipment in use will include excavators, vacuum trucks and compaction machinery.
- Traffic controls will be in place for the duration of the works, including reduced speed limits and 'Stop & Go' traffic guidance.

Traffic control staff will be onsite as per the map below to direct traffic and ensure a safe working environment. For your safety, please follow the directions of traffic controllers at all times. The traffic control arrangement will be subject to change as required for infrastructure installation underneath the roads.
